<p>Embassies: Limited placements available as very few embassies are willing to accept short term interns. Also, clearance needed.</p>	<p>International NGOs (international affairs) Public Affairs</p>

<p>Film/TV/Radio: Limited placements available. <p>Finance and Accounting: Limited placements available. Party Politics: No placements available. The political scene in Prague is small. Parties only accept Czech speaking interns at Masters level, with a long lead time on applications.
